Executive Summary

CIVISCE's Theory of Change outlines a strategic roadmap for achieving transformative and sustainable impact in Tanzania. Grounded in community participation and gender equality, our approach empowers women, young women, and adolescent girls; particularly from marginalized, rural, and humanitarian contexts, to drive positive change in their communities. Through integrated programming across five core areas, we address the root causes of inequality and work towards a future where all women and girls can thrive.

Narrative

CIVISCE's Theory of Change is rooted in the belief that empowering women, young women, and adolescent girls – especially those in marginalized, rural, and humanitarian contexts – can transform communities and drive systemic change toward gender equality, human rights, and sustainable development. We recognize that gender inequality, limited access to sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR), poverty, and climate vulnerability are interconnected challenges. To address these, CIVISCE adopts an integrated, community-driven, and participatory approach that empowers local actors and strengthens the resilience of individuals and systems.

By leveraging community engagement, capacity building, advocacy, partnerships, and resource mobilization, CIVISCE implements targeted interventions across five core programmatic areas:

- Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR)
- Economic and Social Empowerment
- Gender-Based Violence (GBV) Prevention and Response
- Community-Driven Education Support
- Climate Justice and Resilience

These actions lead to short- and medium-term outcomes such as increased awareness of sexual and reproductive health, improved economic skills and climate-smart practices, strengthened community-based GBV response, and greater civic engagement in education and leadership. Ultimately, CIVISCE contributes to the long-term impact of an inclusive, gender-just society where marginalized women and girls thrive socially, economically, and in leadership.
